



LOCK HAVEN AREA YMCA INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

In an effort to maintain a consistent policy when severe winter weather happens in our area, the Lock Haven Area YMCA will have the following protocol in place. When Keystone Central School District closes, delays opening or dismisses early the following program schedule will be followed by the Lock Haven Area Y:

If the Keystone Central School District has a two-hour morning delay, Group Exercise classes will begin at 10 AM. Child Watch will ALSO be delayed and begin at 10 AM. If there is a three-hour morning delay all morning classes and Child Watch are cancelled.

If the Keystone Central School District is closed, all Group Exercise classes are canceled until 4pm. A decision will be made by 2:00pm in regards to all evening Group Exercise classes AND Child Watch/Youth Center.

If the Keystone Central Schools District has an early dismissal, all classes are canceled until 4pm. A decision will be made by 2:00pm in regards to all evening Group exercise classes, adult/youth programs, AND Child Watch/ Youth Center.

In case of late afternoon or evening inclement weather, the status of the facility closing early, including all Group Exercise classes AND Child Watch/Youth Center will be determined by the Group Exercise Instructors (Mandy and Hunter).

COMPETITIVE GYMNASTICS AND SWIM TEAMS: Head coaches will make a decision by 2:00 p.m. and our Member Services Desk will be notified. Both teams will communicate directly with their teams via email and Facebook.

*The School Age program will not be offered at the Y main site. Which means, team members will not be transported to the Y by the School Age program, nor will there be staff for care.

If the decision is made to hold practices, parents should use their best judgment concerning road conditions.
